NEAA is offering 5x10 Grooming Spaces for \$40.

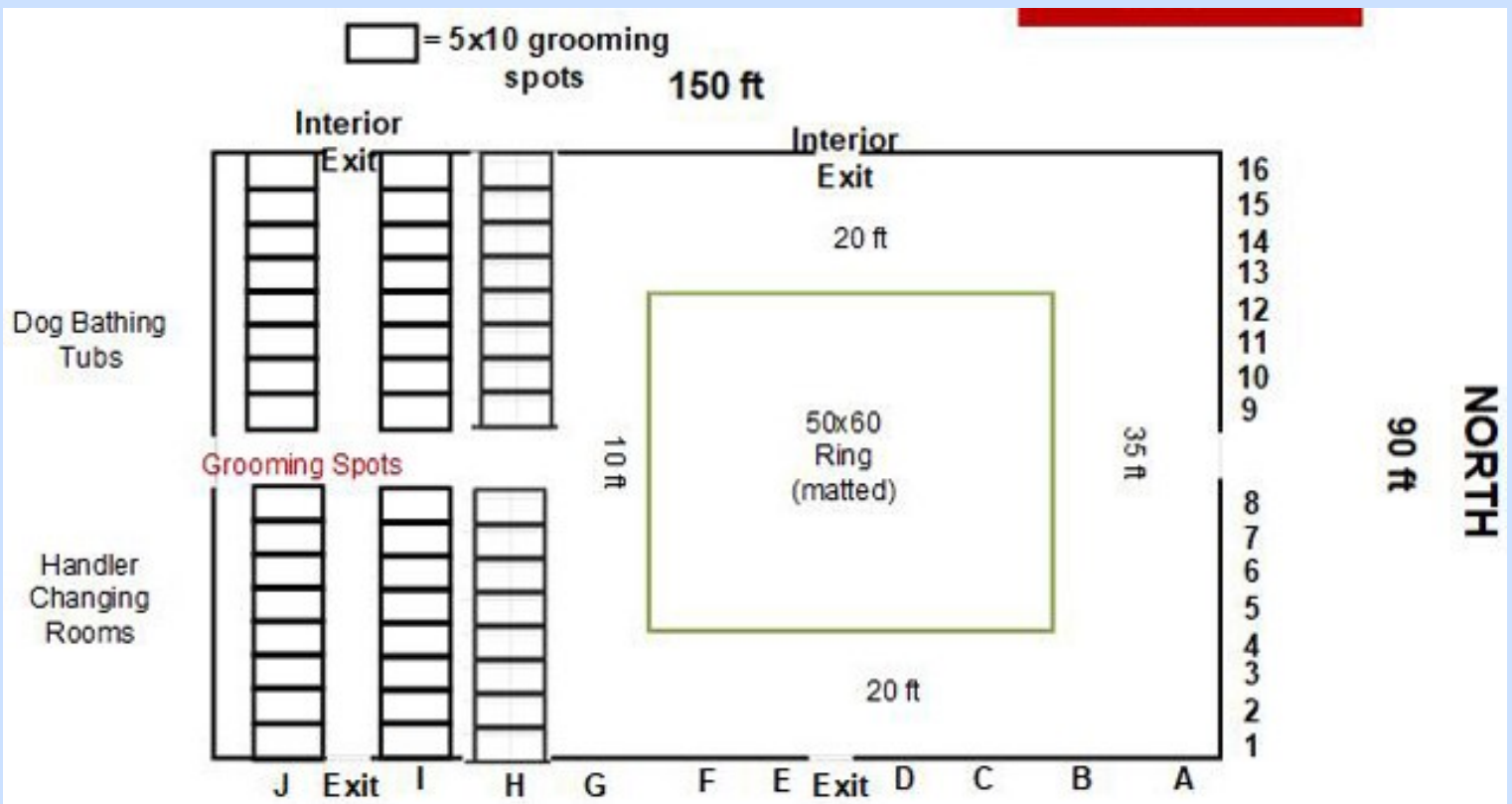
Grooming Space is LIMITED.

It is easy to keep young active dogs in good shape but once they slow down from showing or even during ‘off season’, just like us, dogs lose muscle.

GRAY SUMMIT & ST. LOUIS INFORMATION



Gray Summit Missouri is located about 40 miles west of Downtown St. Louis. St. Louis is full of unique attractions. Most people are familiar with the symbolic Gateway Arch on the Mississippi River, but St. Louis has many attractions worthy of a side trip while you are in Missouri.

Union Station, a National Historic Landmark, opened to the public on Sept. 1st in 1894 and was once the biggest and busiest train terminal in the nation. Now, Union Station is a popular family entertainment complex that includes a hotel, mini-golf course, mirror maze, the St. Louis Wheel (200-foot-tall observation wheel), and a world class aquarium is scheduled to open in December 2019. Admission to the St. Louis Zoo is free and Forest Park, host to the 1904 World's Fair, is regarded as one of the most beautiful urban parks in the world.
